



Every half term at Copp we hold a Spirituality Day. We look at specific Christian values and how we can live them out in our daily lives; we update our reflection area for our chosen value; we write prayers; we read parts of the Bible and we find time to reflect on the awe and wonder of God's world.

Our Christian values in Summer 2 were hope and courage. All classes wrote prayers related to these values and looked for stories and references in the Bible. Pegasus Class read the story of Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers and the parable of the Lost Sheep and discussed the hope found in these. Orion Class used dark glasses to understand what it felt like to be without hope and discussed ways of trying to be a ray of sunshine to others!

We have had a real focus on creating the Big Frieze, which will be displayed in our school hall. Each class has studied a big concept from the Bible: Creation, the Fall, People of God, Incarnation, Gospel, Salvation and the Kingdom of God.
