

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Continue to build good relationships with adults and peers
- Talking about own family and experiences
- By playing cooperatively children can extend ideas in their play

Communication and Language

- Build on listening skills
- Confidence in speaking and sharing ideas
- Maintain concentration for longer periods of time

Mathematics

- Counting forward and back to 5, 10 then beyond.
- Ordering numbers at least up to 10
- Recognising numbers

Literacy

- Recognising letter sounds, blending them together to read simple CVC words;
- Chop words up into the sounds they can hear to spell words.
- (some children) Begin to recognise vowel graphemes (ai, igh, ee)

Expressive Arts and Design

- Recognise and explore how sounds can be changed, sing simple songs from memory
- Exploring different techniques to produce pictures and make Christmas crafts.
